WHEN TO WASH HANDS USING

SOAP AND WATER

- Before eating
- After coughing, sneezing, blowing or cleaning nose. Always cough or sneeze into your elbow or tissue.
- After contact with a sick person
- After using the restrooms
- When entering or leaving the classroom

OR

HAND GEL / RINSE



- After playing outside or inside (recess)
- After working with supplies or objects shared by many individuals
- After contact with a pet or animal

WHEN TO WASH HANDS

USING

ONLY

SOAP AND WATER



- When hands look dirty or are visibly soiled
- After working with art supplies like paints, clay or other similar material
